The Willamette Valley Wolf Pack High School Hockey Team, comprised of high school boys & girls from schools in Eugene, Lebanon, Elmira, Corvallis & Philomath, made their season debut at the Ice Breaker Tournament in Vancouver, Washington this past weekend.

In the first game of the tournament, the Pack was led to a 7-3 victory over Canada's Semiahmoo 5 team by a hat trick from team captain, Kaleb Byers of Philomath.

South Delta, also a Canada based team, was defeated by the Wolf Pack, 3-2, in the second game of pool play. The victory clinched a championship game spot for WVWP. Pack goals were scored by Davi Klappholz-Compton (South Eugene), Kaleb Byers, and Justin Stoner (Churchill High School).
